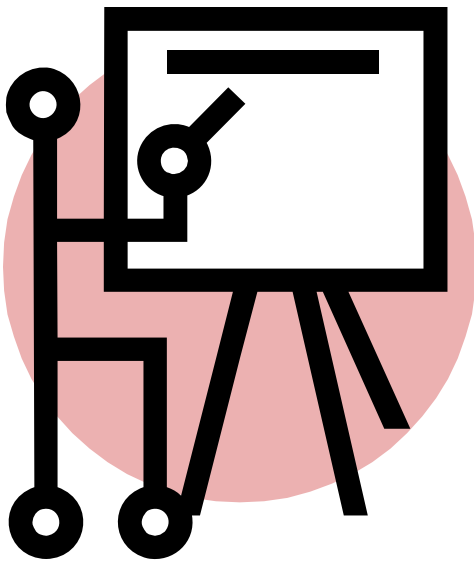


# Case-Based Learning: The Decision-Forcing Case
