What are **P(EQ)** courses?

A new core curriculum will be implemented for new students who enter Nazareth in the fall of 2013. This spring, we will be moving forward with implementation of the new core by offering P(EQ), or Perspectives Enduring Questions, courses for our current students. These courses have significant global or cultural content, and employ writing-to-learn strategies.

How do **P(EQ)** courses count towards the current core?

They count as a PI in the Perspectives area in which the subject falls, as well as a writing intensive (W) AND global (G) course!

How do I know which courses are **P(EQ)**s?

Just look for a “.Q” following the subject in the course number. First Year Seminar P(EQ)s are designated with a “.F.”
